Offered as an aspiration to improve transparency and clarity around the work I do.

1. Upon the foundation of two undergraduate degrees, AS (BYUH) and a BEd (UoW), I have completed the following PLIs. I hold a Certificate in Advanced Skills in Narrative Practice: Narrative Informed Relational Interviewing with Conflicted Couple Relationships (PLI 2023) through VSNT, recognised by CCPA (Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association). Additional PLIs include an IPC in a narrative perspective on conflict resolution (COUNS 546, 2019), UoW., clinical specialist training in counselling to attend to sexual addiction and partner trauma in couple relationships: A multidimensional model to attend to complex trauma, MPTM, (PLI 2022) APSATS.

2. Professionally I describe myself in terms of the work I do within my scope of practice and this is described in clarity [in Scope of Practice on my website](#).

3. In accordance with the [IAMFC Code of Ethics](#), brief notes can be made in each session. A summary can be made available to you if you consent. It can serve as a record that can be a useful reminder of important themes in our conversations.

4. Our conversations are confidential, unless harm is imminent. I may present some of these confidential conversations to supervision, for additional insight. Holding to client anonymity during supervision ensures your confidentiality.

5. Sessions are for 1 hour at a fee of \$135.00 per session.

6. If you provide 24 hours notice of a cancellation, no cancellation fee will be charged. If you do not give 24 hours notice of a cancellation, a 50% cancellation fee may be charged.

7. While it is my expectation that I will provide a quality professional service, if you are not satisfied with the service you have received, you are welcome to discuss this with me. If, after talking with me, you remain dissatisfied, you may 'raise a concern' with my supervisor, or contact the [Health and Disability Commission](#) to submit a formal complaint.
